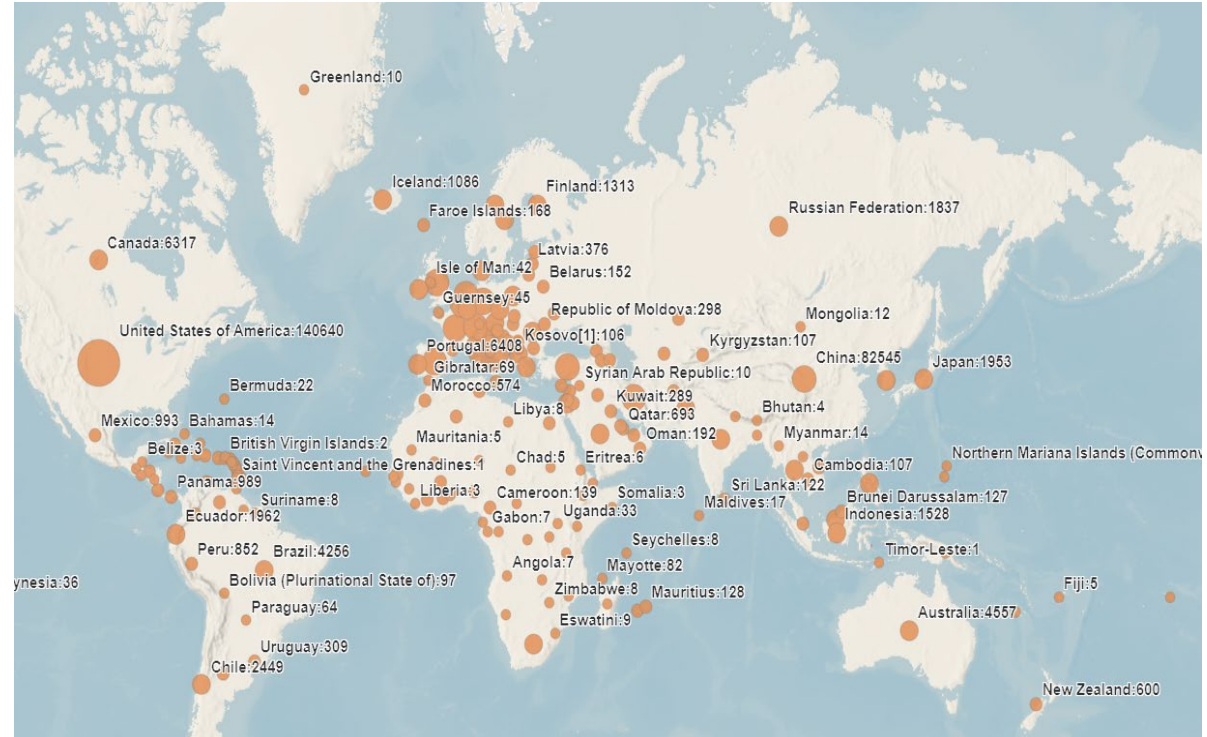

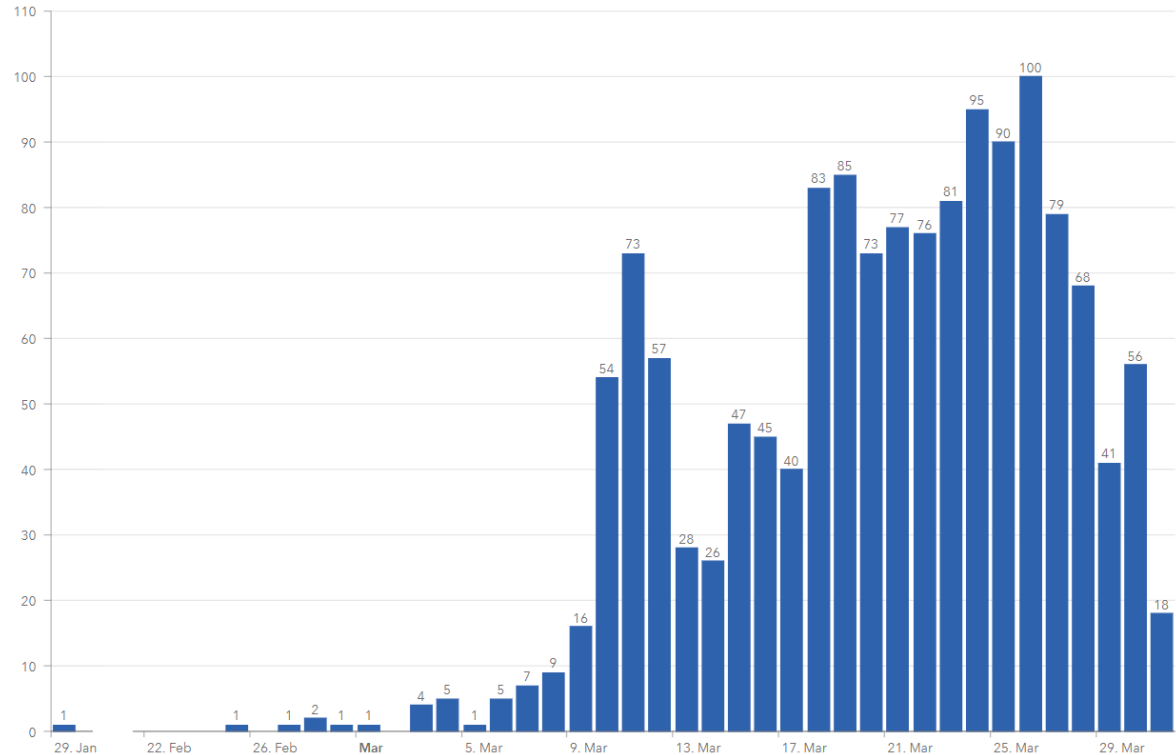
Global COVID-19 pandemic 1 April 2020

- Number of cases detected approx. 780,000
- Deaths approx. 38,000
- Epidemic likely to continue for several months.



Finland – number of cases as of 1 April 2020

- Total number of cases reported 1,446
- The epidemic has progressed more slowly than could be expected without restrictions
- The restrictions appear to have slowed down its progression
- The progression of the epidemic can be monitored via daily situation updates

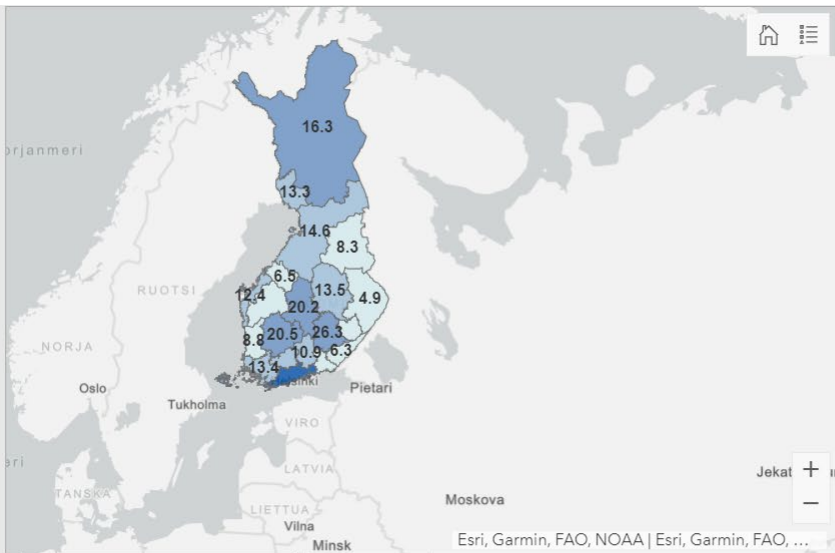

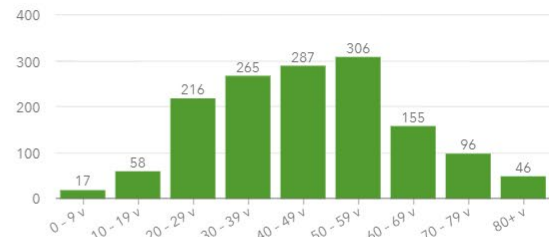

Data in the communicable diseases register is updated with a few days' delay. The data may be updated retroactively. The data is updated at 9.30. The tabs on the map show the incidence of the disease and the number of cases by hospital district. The incidence is the number of cases relative to the population of the region (per 100,000 inhabitants). The tabs on the diagram below show the daily number of cases and the accumulation of cases. 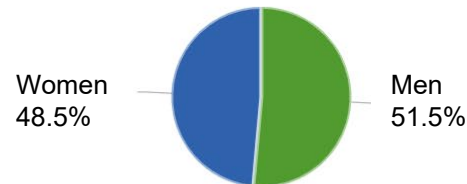


Incidence per 100,000 inhabitants.

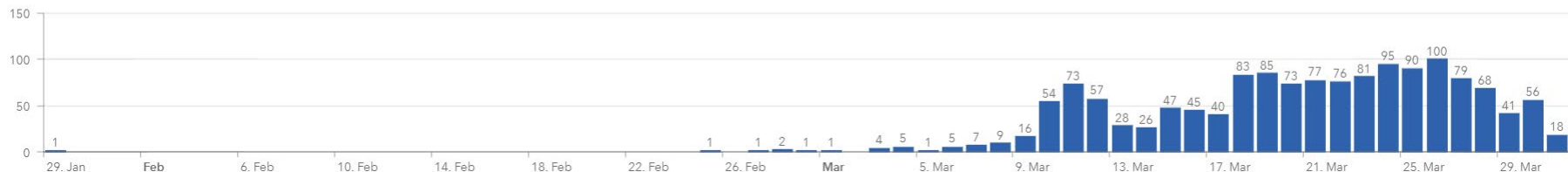
Cases by age group

Number of new cases per day (by sampling date)



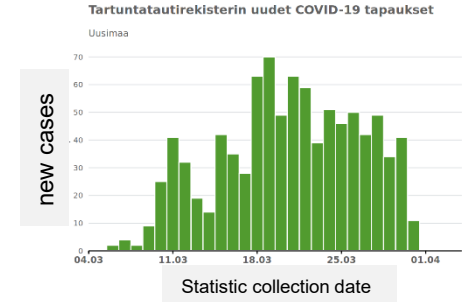
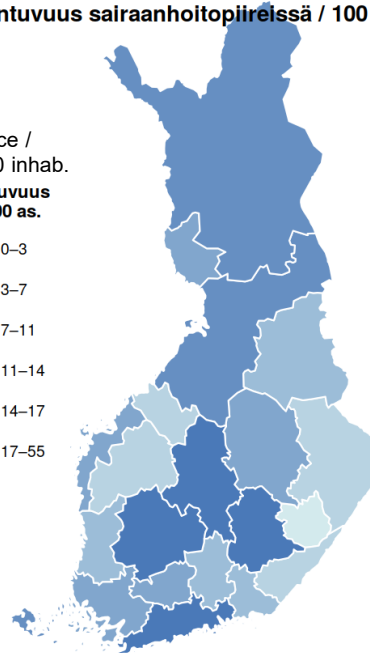
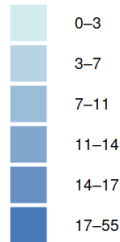
Finland – Hospital districts 1 April 2020

- The epidemic has developed differently depending on the region
- Most cases identified in Uusimaa, which has the highest incidence
- Incidence in Uusimaa about four times higher than in the rest of the country
- Progression has also slowed down in Uusimaa

Finland – Hospital care and deaths (situation on 31 March 2020)

- For the time being, the situation of patients in Finland is reported by catchment area
- The reason for this is to protect individuals' privacy
- Reporting at the hospital district and municipal level will begin as the number of cases increases
