The most important goal of Finland's foreign and security policy is to secure Finland's independence and territorial integrity, prevent Finland from falling into a military conflict and guarantee the safety and wellbeing of Finns. **Comprehensive security** is a Finnish preparedness and resilience model where authorities, businesses, NGOs and citizens are jointly responsible for safeguarding the society's vital functions. The cornerstone is our strong military defence capability, but leadership, businesses, and even ordinary people's resilience all play a vital role.

We'll have a chance to observe the work of the Finnish Border Guard and the Gulf of Finland Coast Guard District out at sea on board the offshore patrol vessel Turva. The Gulf of Finland Coast Guard District is responsible for the operational activities of the Finnish Border Guard in its area of responsibility with border control and maritime safety and security being their core tasks. Their area of responsibility extends from the Hanko peninsula to the eastern Gulf of Finland and the maritime border between Finland and Russia.

During the voyage, the Commander of the Gulf of Finland Coast Guard District will brief us on the maritime functions of the Border Guard, including an operational demonstration.

Important notice: Photography is permitted on the outer deck, in the mess, and on the bridge, provided that no screens or devices are visible in the photos. The crew of the vessel may not be photographed, except for the captain. During the visit, independent movement on the vessel is not allowed. Please, bring weather appropriate clothing!
